Investigation into the death of Oscar N McIntyre

I refer to your letter of 19 July 2016. This letter is the response of PI Operations Pty Ltd to the Coroner's Recommendation that Motorcycling Australia Limited, PI Operations Pty Ltd and the Federation Internationale de Motorcyclisme ensure that a conspicuous visual (non retarding) barrier is installed at the Phillip Island Race Circuit in a position to dissuade riders who have left the track from attempting to cross the infield to re-join the track.

PI Operations Pty Ltd proposes to install an evenly spaced line of polystyrene markers, each with a conspicuous painted chevron indicating that riders should not proceed beyond these markers in the run-off area.

The polystyrene markers are a similar dimension to the brake markers permanently installed in the approach to corners on the Circuit. The attached plan indicates the proposed location of the markers. The markers will be installed within the run off area at the rear of Turn 1 on or before the 15th October 2016. A photo of a proposed marker and a photo of an existing brake marker are also attached.

For international events (being the World Superbike and Moto GP events), PI Operations Pty Ltd requires the consent of Federation Internationale de Motorcyclisme to the installation of these markers. PI Operations Ptv Ltd understands that this consent will be provided.
