

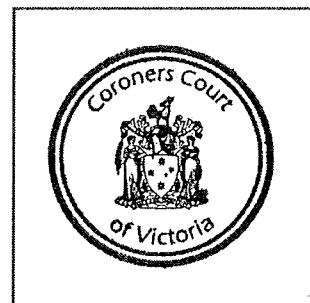

ORDER THAT:

1. The following evidence relating to or in respect of:
 - (a) The operational tactics, procedures (including administrative), capabilities, methodology and equipment of the Special Operations Group, the Critical Incident Response Team, the Canine Unit and the Technical Surveillance Unit of the Victoria Police and the Specialist Response Group of the Australian Federal Police;
 - (b) The training practices (in so far as they relate to the operational and tactical capabilities) and methodologies of the Special Operations Group, the Critical Incident Response Team, the Canine Unit and the Technical Surveillance Unit in Victoria Police and the Specialist Response Group of the Australian Federal Police;
 - (c) The investigative tactics and practices (in so far as they relate to the operational and investigative capabilities) and methodologies of the State Surveillance Unit and the Fugitive Taskforce of the Victoria Police;not be published or broadcast in Victoria or elsewhere, as pursuant to section 18(2) of the *Open Courts Act 2013* I am satisfied that disclosure would be contrary to the public interest.
2. I further direct that this order remain in place until otherwise ordered, but no longer than 27 July 2020.

NOTE: Under section 23 of the **Open Courts Act 2013**, a person must not engage in conduct that constitutes a contravention of a suppression order. Individual penalty: maximum 5 years imprisonment or 600 penalty units or both. Body corporate: 3000 penalty units.
