

ORDER AS FOLLOWS

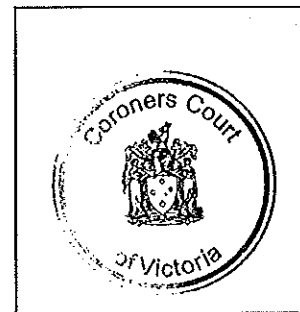

Pursuant to section 18 (2) of the *Open Courts Act 2013* I order that paragraphs 31 to 41 inclusive in my finding dated 18 September 2014, not be published on the basis that publication of these paragraphs might potentially prejudice the fair trial an accused person in respect of the death of Mrs Lucia Amenta.
2. These orders will remain in operation unless otherwise ordered, but no longer than 17 September 2019, at which time the necessity to continue the proceeding suppression order may be reviewed.
