Coroner's investigation into the death of Russell McLarty

On 7 November 2006 Russell McLarty died at the Alfred Hospital having sustained injuries in the car park of the Caledonian Hotel Warrnambool on 5 November 2006 following a dispute with a person known to him, also being a customer of the hotel.

In the dispute allegedly related to drugs Mr McLarty was hit and upon falling hit his head on the back of a car and then the car park surface.

In an 88 page decision the Coroner expressed concern that an off-duty police officer who was aware of and attended the incident failed to appreciate that Mr McLarty had been assaulted, but rather that he had suffered a medical problem.

As a consequence, hotel staff did not contact the police based on their understanding that the off-duty police officer, who was known to them, had already done so.

Without assigning any blame or responsibility to the licensee and/or his staff, the Coroner recommended that AHA (Vic) inform members of the circumstances of Mr McLarty's death and encourage licensees to always contact police when they become aware that a serious assault has occurred on licensed premises.
