- 2. The coronial brief has fully addressed the circumstances of death.


"Mr Kowalczyk was a mentally handicapped male and lived in a supervised Department of Human Services premises at 5 Ramleh Road, Reservoir. On the 23rd April, 2010 he presented at the Austin Hospital Emergency Department suffering breathlessness. He was examined and diagnosed with chronic heart disease and multi-organ failure. At 1600 on the 10th May, 2010, he was transferred to the palliative care ward at the Austin Repatriation Hospital. On the 11th May, 2010, he complained of chest pain and

### **Post Mortem Medical Examination**

- 3. On the 12th May, 2010, Dr Michael Burke, Forensic Pathologist at the Victorian Institute of Forensic Medicine, performed an external examination only on the body of Wladislaw Kowalczyk.
- 4. Dr Burke found the cause of death to be severe congestive heart failure and ischaemic cardiomyopathy.

## **Finding**

I find the cause of death of Wladislaw Kowalczyk to be severe congestive heart failure and ischaemic cardio nyopathy.
