The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) acknowledges receipt of your letter dated 15 November 2018 regarding the death of Baby B (Court ref: COR 2014 004591).

Pursuant to Section 72(2) of the Coroners Act 2008, the RACGP responds to the recommendation as follows:

Recommendation

That the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners develop a RACGP website link to the 'Substance Use during Pregnancy' information.

Substance use during pregnancy

The Coroners Court of Victoria recently made a recommendation to the RACGP following the death of a newborn. The Coroner has asked the RACGP to remind its members to refer to information on substance use during pregnancy, available at the <u>health.vic website</u>.

The information includes advice for the antenatal, perinatal and postpartum management of infants and mothers with a chemical dependency.

GPs can also refer to the <u>Guidelines for preventive activities in general practice</u> 9th edition (the Red book) for further advice on preventive activities and preconception care.
