

ORDER AS FOLLOWS

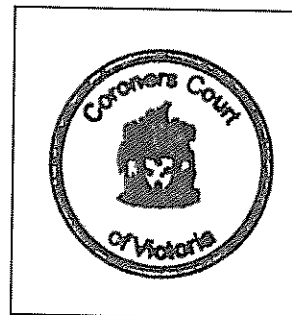
