Thank you for your letter dated 22 January 2020 forwarded to the Minister for Fishing and Boating, Jaala Pulford, MP, regarding the investigation of the death of Yik Sua Hong.

I note the original correspondence from the Coroners Court was addressed to the Minister for Agriculture, Jaclyn Symes. As the matter falls within my portfolio responsibilities, it has been referred to me for response. I would like to extend my condolences to the Hong family for their loss.

Rock fishing safety is vitally important in Victoria. Work has been done here in recent years to raise education and awareness amongst fishers. A summary of this information can be viewed at https://lsv.com.au/research/rock-fishing/

With respect to the recommendations in your report, please note that the Victorian Fisheries Authority will work with other agencies such as Life Saving Victoria, VRFish, local councils and the multicultural community on future education strategies that promote safe fishing practices.

The VFA is also closely monitoring developments in New South Wales with their trial to regulate wearing personal floatation devices. The VFA will continue to keep a watch on this trial interstate and consider any key learnings for Victoria.
