This letter provides the actions that will be, taken by Cohuna District Hospital to address the Coroners recommendations.

1. Recommendation 1

Under section 72(2) of the Coroners Act 2008, the coroner recommended that:

Cohuna District Hospital provides psychosocial supports for residents in the aged care and palliative care programs.

Response to Recommendation 1

- 1.1 Investigate options for enhanced psychosocial supports in aged care. Services include; Adjusted cognitive behaviour therapies, reminiscence therapies, validation therapy
- 1.2 Partnership with Bendigo Health Care Group for the provision of digital mental health services.
- 1.3 Review policy and processes to align with the Beyond Blue document What works to promote emotional wellbeing in older people. A guide for aged care staff working in community or residential care settings. Beyond Blue

2. Recommendation 2

Strengthen staff training in the assessment of suicide risk for aged care and palliative patients.

Response to Recommendation 2

- 2.1 Provide training for staff on suicide risk assessment specific to aged and residential services. Access training modules through Suicide Risk Assessment Australia. Suicide Risk Assessment | Suicid
- 2.2 Mental Health Victoria *Calm Conversations* training for suicide prevention modules will be made available for all Cohuna District Hospital staff. <u>Mental Health Victoria | Training and workforce development (mhvic.org.au)</u>

3. Recommendation 3

Develop a flowchart outlining access to mental health services for residents in the aged care and palliative programs.

Response to recommendation 3

3.1 A flowchart will be developed following consultation with medical staff and Mental Health services.

4. Recommendation 4

Update the suicide risk procedure for aged care and palliative programs.

Response to recommendation 4

- 4.1 Update Aged Care Standard Two Ongoing Assessment and Planning with Consumer policy.
- 4.2 Review and include outcomes of coroners' recommendations to Recognising and responding to clinical/psychological deterioration- aged care policy.
- 4.3 Review Aged Care Goals of care in residential care policy to reflect the learnings from this incident.

Cohuna District Hospital will take all reasonable steps to ensure our residents psychosocial wellbeing is considered and residents needs are identified and addressed in a timely manner in line with the above recommendations.

The Board have agreed that the Accountable officer for this action Plan is the Chief Executive Officer, Ms. Bernadette Loughnane and she has allocated responsibility accordingly to appropriate team. The Board will continue to have governance of this and will receive regular updates both at the Board of Directors Meeting and the Quality and Safety Sub-committee.
