Dear Judge Cain

This document provides the response to your recommendation to Victoria Police arising from the Finding into the death of Gabriel Messo, delivered on 1 December 2022 (the Finding).

Recommendation

At paragraph 356 of the Findings, you made the following recommendation:

I recommend that the Chief Commissioner of Police reviews the feasibility of acquiring technology facilitating the automatic activation of members' Body Worn Camera upon a police issued firearm being withdrawn from its holster (for example the Axon Signal – Sidearm technology).

This recommendation is under consideration.

Victoria Police is investigating the feasibility of acquiring and implementing technology to automatically activate Body Worn Cameras (**BWCs**) when a firearm is withdrawn from its holster, which would enable this recommendation to be acquitted.

Other action taken by Victoria Police

As you correctly highlighted at paragraph 342 of the Findings, the Chief Commissioner of Police's *Instruction CCI 06/19 – Body Worn Camera Deployment* was superseded on 10 December 2020 by the *Victoria Police Manual Body Worn Cameras* (the **Manual**).

The Manual now states that 'a member wearing a BWC <u>must</u> start a recording when exercising a legislated or common law power ... or to capture an incident occurring, likely to occur or which has occurred.'

Further matters

Victoria Police thanks you for your recommendation and will endeavour to address the issues identified in your Finding.
